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Chacra gets their distinct flavor from growing their grapes in Patagonia, Argentina, a desert oasis made possible by snowmelt from the Andes Mountains. Thanks to the dry, pristine air, Chacra Pinots possess a consistently appetizing flavor from vintage to vintage.

Red fruits led by strawberry, cherry and raspberry meet musty earth and smoke, along with hints of pepper and tomato vine. This is a medium-bodied pinot with balanced acidity and plump tannins.
